08 Nights/09 Days

1N Mysore – 2N Coorg – 2N ooty- 2N kodaikennal- 1N Bangalore

Day 1 : Bangalore : Mysore (140kms/3hrs)

On arrival at the Bangalore railway station / airport you will be met by our representative transfer to a Mysore, and drive to Mysore. En route visit Srirangapatnam-the 18th century Summer Palace of Tipu Sultan. Mysore is the second-largest city in the state of Karnataka, India. Located at the base of the Chamundi Hills about 146 km (91 mi) southwest of the state capital Bangalore, it is spread across an area of 128.42 km² (50 sq mi). On arrival and transfer to hotel. Afternoon city sightseeing tour including the Palace of Maharaja of Mysore. Evening visit the Devraja flower market. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Mysore..

Day 2 : Coorg: (100 KMS / 03.5 Hrs)

On arrival at Coorg, Check in to the hotel. Today we take you to Talcauvry (the origin point of River Cauvery) and Bhagamandala (the point where Cauvery assumes the shape of a river. Later visit the ancient temple and in the evening, go to Madikeri town and enjoy shopping for honey, coffee and spices as souvenirs of your travel to Coorg. Night stay at hotel.

Day 3 : Coorg

Morning breakfast and proceed for full day sight seeing covering Talakaveri - Talakaveri is famed as a mountain region with the original source of famous river Cauvery and hence the name Tala-Cauvery (head of Cauvery). It is a holy pilgrim center for Hindu devotees and is located in the Brahmagiri hill at 1,276 m above the sea level. Baghamandala- Bhagamandala, also known as Bhagundeshwara Kshetra, is a temple town. When the river Cauvery flows downhill, two more tributaries namely Kanake and Sujyoti join it. The spot where all three converge is called Bhagamandala, afternoon return to hotel, evening visit Onkareshwara Temple, Raja Seat. Rest of the day free at leisure . Overnight stay at Madikeri.

Day 4 : Coorg-ooty

After breakfast check-out from hotel and drive to Ooty. The "Queen of Hill stations" Ooty in the south of India is a famous tourist attraction, mainly for its natural beauty. It has grown to be one of the most famous hill stations in India. Ooty or Udhagamandalam is the capital of the Nilgiri district. The climate of this place is generally pleasant and thus suitable for leisure tours. The major attractions of this hill station are the green valleys, beautiful mountains and the vast tea estates. On arrival and transfer to hotel and rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight stay in Ooty

Day 5 : Ooty

Morning after breakfast proceed for half day tour of the Botanical Gardens and the Museum with the numerous varieties of ornamental trees and plants is an attraction for all tourists, One can see the best profiles of nature, each embedded with a distinctive grandeur. It's the majestic waterfalls, never-ending forests, and beautiful tea gardens, lush green meadows, placid lake, manicured golf courses that are really spellbinding. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at Ooty.

Day 6 Ooty – Kodaikanal

Morning breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to Kodaikanal.

Kodaikanal is the most beautiful and popular hill station in Tamil Nadu. It is located in the famous Palani Hills in Western Ghats and is known as the Princess of hill stations. Day 07 Kodaikanal

Morning breakfast, proceed to full-day sight seeing visiting to Coakers walk - It offers some of the best views of the plains, Green Valley View - this point commands a beautiful view of the entire Vaigai Dam, this place was once known as "Suicide point", Pillar Rocks - Three boulders stand here, shoulder-to-shoulder, vertically, Silent Valley View - which provides a breathtaking view of Silent Valley, Berijam Lake View - this place provides a panoramic landscape view of Berijam Lake. Silver cascade falls - the overflow of Kodai Lake comes down here as a 180 foot high waterfalls. Return back to hotel and Rest of the day free at leisure . overnight stay at Kodaikanal

Day 08 : Kodaikanal - Bangalore 450k.m

Morning breakfast, checkout from hotel and proceed to

Bangalore is fast growing metropolis, the garden city of Bangalore is the capital of the southern Indian state of Karnataka. Situated at about 1000 meters above sea level, it is known for its salubrious climate where temperatures remain moderate through out the year.

Day 09 Bangalore
